Materials

Size US 4/3.5mm needles.

400-440 yards of laceweight yarn. I used KnitPicks Shadow (50g/440 yards).

Finished Length

60"

Pattern Notes

Anya is garter stitch based, so there is no right and wrong sides. ALL blank stitches are knit stitches, all decreases are worked as if from the right side of the fabric.

Chart Key

□	Knit.
○	YO
∧	K2tog
∧	K2tog tbl
▲	sl1-k2tog-ssso

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Directions

Cast on 51 sts, knit 10 rows. On last row, place marker 5 sts from either end to create selvage. These first and last stitches are knit every row. The chart is for the 41 stitches between these selvages.

*Work section A 8 times, then work section B; repeat from * four times more, for a total of 5 repeats. Work section A 8 times. Work section C. Knit 10 rows, bind off (is a simple pattern). Block lightly. Enjoy!
