Field of Flowers Scarf




Chart Symbols

knit stitch (garter stitch). Blank squares on odd rows in the pattern outline must be knitted. The numerals e.g. '7' on row 1, simply means knit 7 stitches.

= make 1 (yarn over - y.o.; this is a single increase).

knit 2 together, when you knit
2 together, you make a slanted
single decrease - the direction of slash shows the direction the slanted decrease lies.

knit 2 together 'through back of loops' or slip1, knit 1, pass slipped stitch over.

Use a Shetland Lace weight Wool and needles to suit – swatch beforehand and block / dress sample to decide this; consider working even rows in purl for stockinette/stocking stitch (ss) - chart symbols for even rows would have to be changed by purling these rows for ss. X = cast off a stitch, each edging point needs 5 sts cast off loosely.

Cast on with Knitting Cast On 13 stitches and knit edging pattern as shown by LH side for 14 complete points. Keep edging stitches on RH needle and with casting on tail on LH side, pick up from straight edge 85 sts – that's 6 per point and 1 extra. Pick up 13 stitches from Knitting Cast On to form new RH edging side: 13 + 85 + 13 = 111 sts in all. – turn and immediately start patterning for scarf as shown by above chart from row 1.

Repeat lines shown by orange lines on chart – repeat rows 5 to 4 to length of scarf desired, then work final rows 5 to 12 (as shown above the blue bar line on chart). Do not cast off, but again working from the LH edging knit 14 edging points along the top – to match those made at start. Graft/sew the LH edging stitches to the RH edging stitches.

Sew in ends and block/dress.
