## Simpliworsted Linen Stitch Tie

A free download pattern designed by Michael Wade for skacel collection, Inc.

**SKILL LEVEL**: Easy

YARN WEIGHT: Worsted

**FEATURED YARN: Simpliworsted** by **HiKoo** 55% Merino Superwash, 28% Acrylic, & 17% Nylon - 140 yds / 100g. Shown in Color #011 (Indigo).

#### **SIZE AND MATERIALS:**

Size	One size
Length	Approx 56"
Width	Approx 1.75"
Yarn	1 hank (140 yds)

#### addi Needles:

4 mm (approx US 6) circular needle

or size needed to obtain gauge.

#### **Additional Notions:**

Tapestry needle

All yarn and needles distributed by skacel collection, Inc.

#### **GAUGE:**

24 sts and 36 rows = 4" x 4" in Linen Stitch

To save time, check your gauge and read all instructions thoroughly before beginning.

#### **STITCH PATTERN:**

### Linen Stitch:

Row 1: \*K1, sl1 wyif; repeat to end of row. Row 2: \*P1, sl1 wyib; repeat to end of row.

#### **INSTRUCTIONS:**

**Note:** To create the dense fabric necessary for this design, a needle size much smaller than that suggested for the yarn should be used.

CO 14 sts.

Work in Linen Stitch Pattern for 27".

**Dec Row:** K1, sl1 wyif, SSK, k2tog, k1, sl1 wyif, k2tog, SSK, sl1 wyif =10 sts

Beg with Row 2 of Linen Stitch Pattern, work for 29".

#### FINISHING:

Bind off all sts, and weave in yarn tails.

#### Optional Tie Tuck:

CO 4 sts and work in stockinette stitch for 1.5". Bind off. Attach tie tuck to back of tie to keep the tie in place.

#### **ABBREVIATIONS:**

approxapproximate(ly)COCast On

dec decrease(s)/decreasing/decreased

**k** knit

**k2tog** knit 2 stitches together (decreases 1 stitch)

**p** purl

pm place markerPU Pick UpRS Right Side

SSK Slip 2 stitches knit wise, one at a time, from the left needle

to the right needle, then insert the left needle into the front of the slipped stitches and knit them together (decreases

1 stitch).

st(s) stitch(es)

slip (unless otherwise stated, slip as if to purl)

sm slip marker

wyif with working yarn held in front of work

x time(s)

yo yarn over needle to make a new stitch
